

General Conditions for the One-year Intensive Course of the Czech Language

The organizer of the one-year intensive course of the Czech language ("Course") is Tomas Bata University in Zlín, a public university established by Act No. 404/2000 Coll., On the Establishment of Tomas Bata University in Zlín, ID 70883521, registered at Náměstí T. G. Masaryka 5555, 760 01 Zlín (hereinafter referred to as the "University").

The course runs from October to May at the premises of the University, with a three-week break during the Christmas season. The guarantor of the course is the vice-rector for lifelong learning. Teaching is provided by qualified lecturers able to communicate in English. Lessons take place on working days, usually with 5 teaching units per day (one teaching unit lasts 45 minutes). The total number of teaching units is 700. After finishing the course, graduates can apply for an official B2-level Czech language exam, organized by a third party, the price of which is not included in the course fee.

The fee for Course is EUR 2,200. After submitting an application, the applicant will receive an invoice. The invoiced amount is to be paid by the due date stated on the invoice, but no later than on the day of admission to the Course, otherwise the applicant will not be allowed to participate. T. Bati 152, 761 20 Zlín, account owner: UTB ve Zlíně, nám. T. G. Masaryka 5555, 760 01 Zlín. The price of the Czech language course includes tuition and learning materials (textbooks).

Participation in the course can be cancelled by 31 August of the calendar year in which the course is to be commenced, only by means of a written document delivered to czech@utb.cz. In this case, the University will deduct a cancellation fee of EUR 100. The course fee (reduced by the cancellation fee of EUR 100) will be returned within thirty days from the date of receipt of the written cancellation request to the same account from which the fee was paid. In case of cancellation of participation in the course after 31 August, the cancellation fee is 100% of the course price, i. e. EUR 2,200.

The University reserves the right to cancel the course. In this case, the participants will receive a refund of the full amount paid. In the event that a cancellation occurs after tuition has started, the participants will receive a proportional refund.

Applicants who wish to enter the course after tuition has started are required to pay the full fee.

Course participants can use the catering and accommodation services provided by the university. More detailed information for the current academic year will be sent to the applicants after they submit an application.
