

General Conditions for the One-year Intensive Course of the Czech Language

Introductory provisions

The organizer of the one-year intensive course of the Czech language ("Course") is Tomas Bata University in Zlín, a public university established by Act No. 404/2000 Coll., On the Establishment of Tomas Bata University in Zlín, ID 70883521, registered at Náměstí T. G. Masaryka 5555, 760 01 Zlín (hereinafter referred to as the "University" or "Provider"). For the purposes of these general conditions "Customer" is a person, who enrolled to the One-year Intensive Course of the Czech Language under these General Conditions.

The General Conditions make an integral part of the contract between the Provider and the Customer. The contract between the Provider and the Customer is based on the Customer's application for the Course (hereinafter referred to as the "Contract").

Object of the contract

Subject of the Course is teaching Czech language under these General Conditions.

Course specification

The course runs from January 4th to May 31st 2021 at the premises of the University, The guarantor of the course is the Vice-rector for pedagogical activities. Teaching is provided by qualified lecturers able to communicate in English. Lessons take place on working days, usually with 7 teaching units per day (one teaching unit lasts 45 minutes). The total number of teaching units is 700. After finishing the course, graduates can apply for an official B2-level Czech language exam, organized by a third party, the price of one exam application is included in the course fee. The exam is organized during June. The price of the Course includes tuition and learning materials (textbooks).

Fee and payment terms

The fee for the Course is EUR 2,500. After submitting an application, the applicant will receive an invoice within two weeks. The invoiced amount is to be paid by the due date stated on the invoice, but no later than on November 13th 2020, otherwise the applicant will not be allowed to participate. Termination

Participation in the course can be cancelled 30 days before the start of the course only by means of a written document delivered to czech@utb.cz. In this case, the University will deduct a cancellation fee of EUR 250. The course fee (reduced by the cancellation fee of EUR 250) will be returned within thirty days from the date of receipt of the written cancellation request to the given account number confirmed by applicant. In case of cancellation of participation in the course is shorter than 30 days or during running the course, the cancellation fee is EUR 250 for each month.

The University does not accept transfer a tuition to the next year of the Course.

The University reserves the right to cancel the course. In this case, the participants will receive a refund of the full amount paid. In the event that a cancellation occurs after tuition has started, the participants will receive a proportional refund.

Other terms

Customers who wish to enter the course after tuition has started are required to pay the full fee.

Course participants can use the catering and accommodation services provided by the University. More detailed information for the current academic year will be sent to the applicants after they submit an application.

Processing of personal data

By signing these General Conditions Customer agrees to provide his/her personal data to the University. The Customer declares that the personal data provided are true. University is the personal data controller in this relationship and undertakes to dispose of it in accordance with the applicable legislation, in particular with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR"). In accordance with Article 6 (1) (b) the GDPR University is authorized to process personal data for the purpose of concluding and fulfilling the contract. The Customer acknowledges that the processing of his/her personal data pursuant to the previous sentences does not require the Customer's consent.

University confirms, that it is aware, that the customer has rights specified in the GDPR.

Customer declares, that is informed sufficiently about his/her rights in the matter of personal data.

University undertakes to take all measures to prevent unauthorized or accidental access to, alteration or destruction, loss or unauthorized transmission of personal data, of the unauthorized processing thereof, and other misuse of personal data.

If necessary, the Customer is entitled to contact the Provider's Data Protection Officer at dpo@utb.cz.

The Customer's personal data will be processed for the duration of the Contract concluded on the basis of the Application. University undertakes to delete the processed personal data without undue delay after the termination of the contract, unless otherwise provided by law.

Dispute resolving

In the event of disputes between the University and the Customer, both parties undertake to resolve the dispute by mutual agreement between them. If the parties fail to settle the dispute by agreement, they have the right to apply to the competent court.

Final provisions

Legal relationships not expressly regulated by these General Conditions are governed by Act no. 89/2012 Coll., The Civil Code.
